the proposed project	seen as vital elements of fair working conditions and freedom

	(and particularly those working in visual arts and coming from
	vulnerable groups) fell deeper into precariousness and poverty,
	especially after COVID pandemic. New, alternative models of
	organization and economies that would safeguard a minimum
	standard of income for artists are therefore much needed.
	Thus, ULUS is proposing the project dealing with alternative
	economic models primarily in different forms of cooperatives
	that ensure labour and social security, career development, job
	creation, market expansion, business model innovation. This
	project gathers 13 most active small-scale European
	organizations driven by a strong desire to create fair practices
	and stimulating fair working conditions in visual arts.
