Aims and activities of the organisation	<p><i>Founded in 2018, is a creation and audience mediation structure and dance company, where contemporary dance is the point of contact and departure for the research of ideas and ecosystems that are in constant movement, dialogue and interaction with various directions and layers.</i></p> <p><i>Between 2023 and 2024, the company collaborated on the international project (Creative Europe) PANG - Performing Arts for the Next Generation, where artists work together in a process of co-creation with teenagers, between four countries, coordinated by Drama Teatro (Italy), Slovenia, Estonia and Portugal.</i></p> <p><i>In 2022, Madrasta opened her space C.A.R.MA. - Casa Artística e Rural da Madrasta, in the small village Pias, located in Ferreira do Zêzere (centre of Portugal), with the aim of bringing together and developing projects in the area of contemporary dance and the performing arts for the community and in the central interior of Portugal.</i></p> <p><i>It holds and promotes various workshops and regular classes in dance and video editing. In October 2023, it premiered its 1st Edition of the Zêzere Cinedança International Festival, a festival aimed at professionals in the field of video-dance and choreo-cine. In 2024, it created and organized the 1st edition of ARADO - Dance and Performing Arts Festival, in the village of Pias, in Ferreira do Zêzere.</i></p>
