Organisation type	The Théâtre de Saint-Nazaire is one of the 78 "scènes nationales" (a label awarded by the Ministry of Culture that span the French territory). The theatre has an 800-seat auditorium and a large rehearsal studio that can accommodate an audience (up to 200 people). It also runs a cinema that is a member of the Europa network. Theatre and cinema activities attract around 90,000 spectators per season.	
	The budget is around 3M€ and it employs 27 persons

Aims and activities of the organisation	Its missions are to support creation (5 to 10 projects supported per year), to present a multidisciplinary program (around 100 performances per year), and to carry out an important work to raise awareness of art and culture within its local area.	
	The theatre is at the heart of the city of Saint-Nazaire (70,000 inhabitants and 150,000 for the global area, located in western France, 70 kilometres from Nantes).

Yes The theatre's artistic and cultural project is to offer a vision and provoke reflection through artists' perspectives on the problems and challenges of our contemporary world. The theatre's direction is open to collaborating on a European project focused on the performing arts and mostly if it is connected with the specific characteristics of its territory. The territory has many particularities: - Geographical location: Saint-Nazaire is a maritime (Atlantic) and
	riverine city (at the mouth of the Loire) with a port (which also serves the city of Nantes) and beaches. - History: the region has a legacy linked to the slave trade and played an important role during both world wars (landings during the First World War, a major submarine base during the Second World War). Saint-Nazaire was also the departure port for transatlantic liners at the end of the 19th century. - Architecture: completely razed during the Second World War, it was rebuilt in the 1950s.
	 Industry: Saint-Nazaire is a large employment area (Chantiers de l'Atlantique and Airbus Industrie) that is shifting towards decarbonised industry (construction of offshore wind turbines). Sociological and civic aspects: the area has a higher-than-average working-class population and enjoys a very active associative life (1,200 associations). Ecology / quality of life: Saint-Nazaire faces pollution issues and is working on quality-of-life matters.
